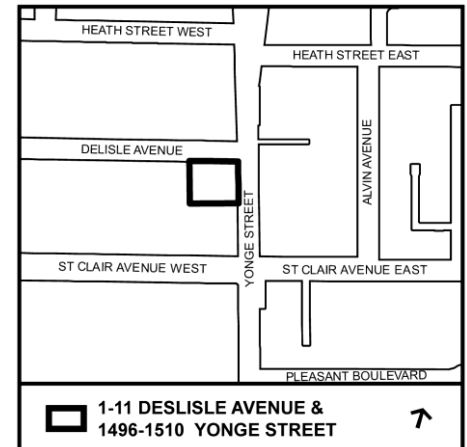

Place: 1585 Yonge Street (Yorkminster Park Baptist Church, Heritage Room)

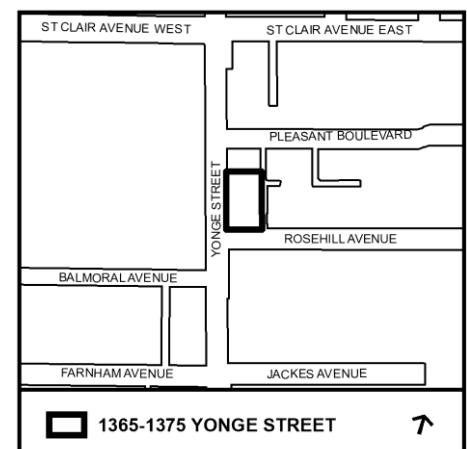
The City has received applications to amend the Official Plan and Zoning By-law for a 48-storey (168-metre including the mechanical penthouse) mixed-use building with 263 dwelling units and retail uses at grade. The facade of the existing building at 1496-1500 Yonge Street will be moved and incorporated into the base of the new building.



2) 1365-1375 YONGE STREET

Time: 7:00 PM – 9:00 PM
Place: 1585 Yonge Street (Yorkminster Park Baptist Church, Heritage Room)

The City has received applications to amend the Official Plan and Zoning By-law for a 17-storey (69.5-metre including the mechanical penthouse) mixed-use building consisting of ground floor retail, 310 retirement home rooms, and 93 parking spaces within a 2-level underground garage.
